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CHRISTIE'S AMERICAS TO HOST SALE OF FINE & RARE WINES AT HISTORIC HAMPTONS ESTATE ON JUNE 6

RARE 1929 MAGNUM OF MOËT & CHANDON AUTOGRAPHED BY TINA FEY, ROBERT DOWNEY, JR., MATTHEW BRODERICK AND OTHERS TO BE AUCTIONED FOR CHARITY

New York – Christie's is pleased to announce further details of its first-ever Hamptons Sale, an early summer auction of Fine & Rare wines hosted at an historic waterfront estate in Westhampton Beach, NY on June 6, 2009. As befitting such a regal estate, the sale will offer a broad selection of blue-chip wines including the best of recent vintages suitable for laying down, and older classics that have aged to perfection and are ready for drinking this summer. Of particular note are selections from three private collections that include well-priced, top-quality wines from Burgundy, the Rhône

Valley, Champagne, Alsace, Spain, Italy, Germany, California, Portugal, Australia, and Austria. A total of 793 lots are included in the sale.

The star lot of the sale is an extremely rare magnum of Moët & Chandon Grand Vintage 1929 champagne released this year to commemorate the 81st anniversary of the Academy Awards ceremony and Moët & Chandon's first year as the exclusive champagne of the Oscars®. The bottle's wooden case has been autographed by Hollywood celebrities and Oscars® attendees Tina Fey, Robert Downey, Jr., Matthew Broderick, among others. Proceeds from the sale of this lot (estimate: \$6,000-10,000) will benefit the Motion Picture & Television Fund (MPTF), a leading Hollywood charity that provides health and social services to the entertainment community.







The Grand Vintage 1929 was recently disgorged at Moët & Chandon's cellars in Epernay, France by Chef de Cave Benoit Gouez who tasted the champagne before it was sealed. As Mr. Gouez commented: "This sublime, magnificent champagne is a fitting tribute to the stature and grandeur of the Academy Awards. The 1929 Vintage is a great work of art that pairs beautifully with the level of artistic achievement celebrated at the Oscars® over the past 81 years."

The Atwater Estate, Westhampton, NY

The Atwater Estate is a majestic residence that stretches across more than 1,000 feet of coastline on Quantuck Bay in Westhampton Beach, NY. The historic three-story, shingle-style manor was

originally built for coal baron William C. Atwater between 1900 and 1903. He commissioned the celebrated Beaux Arts architect Henry Bacon of McKim, Mead & White, best known for his design of the Lincoln Memorial in Washington to conceive the estate's inspired design. The wine sale will take place at the estate's Carriage House, which offers breathtaking views of the bay and the estate's lawn and gardens. During the sale, registered bidders will enjoy an outdoor reception sponsored by Newton Vineyards of Napa Valley, CA, which will pour its acclaimed "Unfiltered' wines during the event. Bidders may also tour the main house, which is being offered at \$29 million by Brown Harris Stevens with premier international marking provided by Christie's Great Estates.

Among the many excellent wines featured in the sale will be two impériales (6 liter bottles) of Newton Epic Merlot and Newton Puzzle Cabernet from the legendary 1997 Napa Valley vintage. In addition, an artist-designed wine tasting bar recently commissioned by Newton and created from 100% reclaimed materials will be on display and available for purchase via silent bid. Proceeds from the sale of the custom piece and the Newton auction lots will benefit Global Green USA.
