Ginette Lospinosa, Head of Interiors Department at Christie's New York, comments: "Our final sale of 2009 totaled \$2.59 million – the highest sales total of the year for this category at Christie's New York. Items from all the major collecting categories performed well, led by British and European fine art, Chinese porcelain and decorative art, and a special selection of fine jewelry. As witnessed throughout the season, property from estates and museums continues to entice buyers from both the private and trade sectors, including items from the estate of Hollywood antiques dealer Charles Pollock and the late Wall Street businessman Jack Dreyfus, Jr., among others. Furniture of all periods and styles – including antique French chairs, American clocks, neo-Gothic chandeliers, and chic contemporary designs – were pursued by multiple bidders, and unique items such as vintage Louis Vuitton luggage and a selection of 18th and 19th century snuff bottles soared beyond their pre-sale estimates. This brings our 2009 *Interiors* sales total to approximately \$17.6 million in New York. We look forward to our first sale of 2010, which will feature items from the Collection of John Cage and Merce Cunningham sold to benefit the Merce Cunningham Trust."
