Museum quality works on paper and paintings, such as Camille Pissarro's *La foire de Gisors* and Maurice Denis' *The Awakening,* were sought after by both private clients and trade alike." **Stefany Sekara Morris, Head of the Day Sale**, commented, "A highlight of the sale was Leonard Tsuguharu Foujita's *Nu allongé* à *la toile de Jouy,* which achieved the highest price on the market for the artist in more than two decades at \$1,205,000, doubling its low estimate. We were pleased to see active bidding in the saleroom with new clients from Asia, America and South America, continuing the trend during this week of sales."
