Hong Kong – On 28th November, *The Song of the Pipa Player* by **Fu Baoshi** will be offered in a single lot sale in recognition of this exceptional masterpiece, created by one of the foremost artists in the history of Modern Chinese Art.

Ben Kong, International Specialist Head of Chinese Paintings commented: 'Formerly in the illustrious H.H. K'ung collection, *The Song of the Pipa Player* is a culturally significant work, breaking through the traditional notions of Chinese paintings and forging a ground-breaking approach. This composition stands as one of the greatest examples of Fu Baoshi's sublime skill in artistic expression and composition, and demonstrates his enduring legacy in the field of Chinese Modern paintings.'

The Song of the Pipa Player was composed by Tang dynasty poet Bai Juyi in 816 AD as a reflection of his life experiences. Upon hearing the sad tune of the pipa player and the misfortunes of which she spoke, it stirred up his own feelings of despair over his dismissal from his post as governor, and he felt an affinity with her song and her hardships. Fu Baoshi's interpretation of the poem exudes a pensive and melancholic aura, while the gloomy moonlight creates a sense of detachment. Well-modelled figures, each with unique and contrasting demeanours, blend in the overall dramatic tonality of the painting, while the trees underscore Fu's mastery of brushwork and his skilful play of light.

Created in 1945, this painting stands as one of the best figure paintings by Fu Baoshi and one of his finest artistic achievements. This work comes with exceptional provenance, having been held in one of the most important collections of Chinese modern paintings, by collector K'ung Hsiang-Hsi for over 60 years. This painting first came to light in 2010 when it achieved a record-breaking auction result in our saleroom – more significantly, its rare composition is comparable to a definitive work of the same subject matter, created in 1944, currently housed in the collection of the Nanjing Museum.
