Twenty-two lots consigned directly from the cellars of Chateau Lafite-Rothschild to mark the 90th anniversary year of Michael Broadbent were 100% sold raising £103,380 for two notable charities. Collectors responded enthusiastically to the diverse offering, with the Charles Heidsieck collection also selling 100% by lot totalling £123,180, it was a truly remarkable experience."*
