Ms. Kwan began her showbusiness career in the 1980s at the mere age of 18 with 6 TV shows. On top of that, she filmed her first starring role and performed in a Disney show. Perhaps the most important role in her career was that of her second debut in the film Head Hunter, starring opposite Chow Yun Fat, which immediately gained the attention of large audiences and critical acclaim. Ms. Kwan continued to star in influential roles playing alongside some of the most prominent Hong Kong actors, such as Jackie Chan, Andy Lau, Leslie Cheung, Donnie Yan, etc. In 2000, Ms. Kwan also worked with Chinese director Feng Xiaogang in the Comedy Big Shot's Funeral, playing opposite Hollywood actor Donald Sutherland.

As an outstanding actress, Ms. Kwan is well known for her commendable work ethic and for being one of Hong Kong's most beloved screen icons for over 25 years, with a resume that includes over 60 films and numerous show productions. However, Ms. Kwan refuses to be defined purely by her considerable legacy as an actress. From the early 2000s, she made a conscious decision to devote more of her time and effort to her charitable work, which has included a generous donation of \$2 million to support victims of the 2008 Sichuan earthquake, and volunteering to personally hand-deliver desperately needed aid to sufferers of this tragic incident. În 2010, Ms. Kwan also made a generous donation to a school in Chishui that was experiencing financial straits; these funds helped the locals to significantly upgrade the school's educational facilities and lived environment.

Rosamund Kwan has been hailed as one of the top 50 most beautiful women in the world and her charming and elegant image continues to be a feature of magazine covers and advertising. She is also an iconic figure associated with fashion and luxury lifestyle; as well as being her two Shiba Inus Whiskey and Coffee's loving 'mother', she was also an aerial yoga enthusiast and a drummer.

關之琳女士生於演藝世家,除了是著名影視藝人和企業家外,亦熱衷於慈善事業發展。一覽關芝琳珠寶收藏,便可感受到其個人品味超卓,藝術涵養深厚。其重點收藏珠寶包括國際品牌 Cartier、Van Cleef & Arpels、Buccellati 和 Boghossian 共 51 件珍品。這批積累多年、復古而恆久的珍藏,陪伴了關芝琳的成長和品味培養,也確定了她時尚高雅的生活方式和現代女性典範形象。

關芝琳於 1980 年代開始其演藝生涯,早在 18 歲之齡,已出演 6 部電視劇。不久之後她的第一部擔要角色便是與周潤發搭檔的電影《獵頭》,始備受關注。 1990 年出演《婚姻勿語》並獲得香港電影金像獎的最佳女配角提名,1991 年於徐克導演電影《黃飛鴻》中飾演十三姨,至今仍爲人樂道。 2000 年,關芝琳與中國導演馮小剛合作,於《喜劇大人物的葬禮》中扮演好萊塢演員唐納德薩瑟蘭的對手。在 2007 年宣佈退出娛樂圈前,關芝琳一直與成龍、劉德華、張國榮、甄子丹等多位香港及內地知名的演員演出合共超過六十多部電影及劇集。

從 2000 年代初開始,她將更多的時間和精力投入 到慈善工作中,其中包括 200 萬元慷慨捐贈來支持 2008 年四川地震的受災者,並自願親自運送急需的 物品援助這一悲慘事件的受害者。 2010 年,關女士 還向赤水一所陷入財務困境的學校慷慨捐款,幫助當 地人提升學校的教育設施和生活環境。

關芝琳是滿州皇族瓜爾佳氏後裔,一直被公認爲「香 江第一美女」及「世界最美麗的五十位女性之一」的 女演員。雖然已淡出幕前多年,關芝琳仍然是娛樂圈 追捧的明星,她的優雅形象仍然經常出現在雜誌封面 和廣告。
