

Mr Doodle Caravan Chaos

This Spring, Christie's is beyond excited to unveil *Mr Doodle:* Caravan Chaos in Hong Kong, a dedicated live sale presenting 30 exceptional pieces selected from the artist's unique site-specific artwork created in 2015. Sam Cox, more commonly known as Mr Doodle, is a young British artist whose works are recognized by his iconic doodle clusters. Bold and eccentric, his explosive scribbles of quirky characters are seen on many unconventional mediums, including the unimaginable caravan.

"Doodle World is my imaginary place where all the characters exist and where they come to life." - Mr Doodle

With the artist's consent, the original work **Caravan Chaos** is segmented into multiple panels, each in different size and shape. This sale includes a curated selection of panels that are fun and quirky. For instance, **Panel 2 Side 6** retains the entire door from the caravan with the upper-half being a frosted-glass pane and the lower-half covered by a peculiar, wobbly-eyed character peeping at the door handle, as if tempting its viewers to explore the 'Doodle World' hidden behind this door; **Panel 1 Side 5** depicting a cartoonish crab with stuffed cheeks at the beach suggested by the umbrella and the waves, sharing the same setting as **Side 1 Panel 3** in which the bizarre character with gourd-shape face is wearing a pair of sunglasses. Manifested on an unconventional material and suggested by the nature of caravan, these 30 panels together take its viewers onto a journey through the mise-en-scène of visualized imagination of Mr Doodle's world.

The medium of caravan is not an uncommon choice in the Mr Doodle's oeuvre. He began consumedly doodling on papers endlessly at the young age of nine. As paper soon could no longer satisfy his artistic expression, he then turned to dominate other unorthodox mediums, including plants, clothing, kitchen counters, subways, offices and many more. Mr Doodle started exploring any available surfaces that he could possibly draw on, wrapping these found objects with his outlandish expressions. He transforms an ordinary caravan into the present sale's original Caravan Chaos, just as Yayoi Kusama reimagined a plant with her infinity nets pattern. Completed in 2015, the present project is one of the early works of Mr Doodle, in which the black-andwhite doodles are larger in scale when compared to the more dense, smaller characters from recent oeuvres.

"Letting your hands do the work and just see the characters and the visual come to life by themselves. I try not to take it too seriously. I want it all to be a happy process and I want the final piece to radiate joy within it. The important part is not knowing what's going to come next. It has to grow spontaneously." - Mr Doodle

Although Caravan Chaos is executed with spray paint and the details are more gestural, when compared with fine brushes or marker pen, Mr Doodle strictly identifies himself as a doodle artist but graffiti. The artist takes his inspiration from childhood comic books, video games, and Walt Disney. The imageries in Caravan Chaos - flowing naturally and entangling happily - resemble the two-dimensional graphics in video games and cartoons but are reimagined with the magic of the artist's distinctive working method. Persistently presenting doodling beyond a hobby and as a form of art, Mr Doodle reinterprets the definition and rebels against the traditional established norms in the history of art through taking the lead in representing the possibilities of doodle in his works. Mr Doodle has already garnered huge success by breaking his personal auction records multiple times and yielding supports from international collectors, particularly in Asia. Presenting doodling as an art performance beyond the boundaries of a two-dimensional canvas in Caravan **Chaos**, Mr Doodle is radicalizing the way we experience art.

佳士得香港將於今年春季呈獻「Mr Doodle:瘋狂旅行車」專場拍賣,從藝術家在2015年創作獨一無二的場域特定藝術品中,選出30件非同凡響的作品展現於是次專場拍賣。這位年輕的英國藝術家原名山姆·考克斯(Sam Cox),以其標誌性的幽默塗畫與 Mr Doodle 這個名字聞名於世。藝術家以獨特的個人風格,將稀奇古怪的人物角色塗畫於各種別開生面的材質與媒材之上,這輛《瘋狂旅行車》就是跳出傳統畫布媒材框架的創意之作。

「塗畫世界(Doodle World) 就是我的幻想空間, 所有人物角色都存在於這空間內,更是活在其中。」 - Mr Doodle

這件《**瘋狂旅行車**》經藝術家同意後,被分成了數十個部分,每一件均獨一無二。是次專場拍賣所展現的一系列作品尤為有趣、並別開生面:作品《**右側第6號**》保留了旅行車的整個車門,其上半部是一塊磨砂玻璃面板,下半部則有一個造型離奇、炯炯大

眼的人物角色向門柄窺望,彷彿以眼神示意觀眾一探門後的「塗畫世界」(Doodle World);在《後側第5號》中,描繪了一隻雙頰鼓起的卡通螃蟹遊走在海灘上,並伴有太陽傘和海浪;上述場景和《後側第3號》同出一轍,其中另有一個戴著墨鏡的葫蘆臉型稀奇角色。Mr Doodle 將他的幻想世界描繪在非傳統的材質之上,而媒介本質作為一輔旅行車更是能帶領觀眾在30件作品中游歷,一探藝術家所創造的奇幻空間。

在Mr Doodle 的衆多作品中,旅行車並非一個不常見的媒材選擇。 藝術家從九歲開始便連續不間斷地塗畫紙張,但這材質很快便未 能滿足到他的藝術表達語言,繼而開始征服各種非傳統的媒材, 例如盆栽、衣物、廚櫃、地下鐵、辦公室等。Mr Doodle 更探索 層出不窮的表面,以他別具一格的圖案覆蓋著不同的現成物。藝 術家將一輛平平無奇的旅行車轉化成《瘋狂旅行車》一作,就如 草間彌生以她專屬的卵石狀圓點重新詮釋單調的盆栽。《瘋狂旅行車》完成於 2015 年,為 Mr Doodle 的早期作品,當中黑白色的塗畫圖案面積較大,而藝術家近期作品中的人物角色則比較細小和密集。



相較於藝術家其他出自細筆或馬克筆的作品,《瘋狂旅行車》雖 運用了噴漆並遺留創作過程的痕跡,但 Mr Doodle 重申自己並非 塗鴉藝術家,而是塗畫藝術家。他的靈感來源自童年漫畫書、電 腦遊戲及和路·迪士尼(Walt Disney)。作品中各個形體意像彷 如電腦遊戲和卡通中的平面圖案,而經過藝術家重新詮釋,轉化 成為他獨特的藝術視覺語言,人物角色愉快自然地遊走貫穿於整 輛《瘋狂旅行車》。 Mr Doodle 堅持不懈將塗畫從興趣層面提升 至正統藝術形式,透過不斷拓展塗畫的可能性,更重新定義了塗 畫藝術,並挑戰藝術史中傳統的固有規範。 Mr Doodle 的作品多 次打破其個人拍賣記錄,並得到國際收藏家,尤其亞洲收藏家的 支持,可見藝術家的市場實力。藝術家以行為藝術的方式將塗畫 於《瘋狂旅行車》中表現得淋漓盡致,超越了畫布的平面界限, 並徹底改變我們體驗藝術的模式。

A BEFORE THE SALE

DESCRIPTION OF LOTS

(a) Certain words used in the catalogue description have special meanings. You can find details of these on the page headed "Important Notices and Explanation of Cataloguing Practice" which forms part of these terms. You can find a key to the Symbols found next to certain catalogue entries under the section of the catalogue called "Symbols Used in this Catalogue"

(b) Our description of any **lot** in the catalogue, any **condition** report and any other statement made by us (whether orally or in writing) about any lot, including about its nature or condition, artist, period, materials, approximate dimensions or **provenance** are our opinion and not to be relied upon as a statement of fact. We do not carry out indepth research of the sort carried out by professional historians and scholars. All dimensions and weights are approximate only

OUR RESPONSIBILITY FOR OUR **DESCRIPTION OF LOTS**

We do not provide any guarantee in relation to the nature of a **lot** apart from our **authenticity** warranty contained in paragraph E2 and to the extent provided in paragraph I below.

CONDITION

(a) The **condition** of **lots** sold in our auctions can vary widely due to factors such as age, previous damage, restoration, repair and wear and tear. Their nature means that they will rarely be in perfect condition. Lots are sold "as is" in the condition they are in at the time of the sale, without any representation or warranty or assumption of liability of any kind as to condition by Christie's or by the seller.

OUR AUTHENTICITY WARRANTY

We warrant, subject to the terms below, that the lots in our sales are **authentic** (our **"authenticity warranty"**). If, within 5 years of the date of the auction, you give notice to us that your **lot** is not authentic, subject to the terms below, we will refund the purchase price paid by you. The meaning of authentic can be found in the glossary at the end of these Conditions of Sale. The terms of the authenticity warranty are as follows:


