New York - On May 9, as part of the Post-War & Contemporary Art Evening Sale, Christie's New York will offer *Property from the Judd Foundation*. The selection of works by Donald Judd will provide an overview of the artist's career, the earliest work dating from the early sixties, the latest one executed the year before his death, 1993.
