The Greenwich Concours*

The highlight of the auction will be the David H. Tunick Collection. The auction is to be held at the verdant Roger Sherman Baldwin Park, home of the renowned Greenwich Concours d'Elegance and located on a peninsula at the head of Greenwich Harbor.

Viewing of the consigned cars begins Friday, June 3, with the auction taking place on Sunday afternoon, June 5. The deadline for additional sale consignments is Friday, April 8.

Sale highlights include a 1913 Simplex Model 50 Victoria Touring (estimate: \$350,000-450,000); a 1936 Auburn 852 Supercharged V8 Boattail Speedster (estimate: \$125,000-175,000); a 1955 Mercedes-Benz 300SL Gullwing (estimate: \$110,000-140,000); and a 1935 Bugatti Type 57 convertible (estimate: \$160,000-180,000 and offered with no reserve).
