CHRISTIE'S APRIL 10 & 11 OFFERINGS FEATURE RARE GEMS OF AUSTRALIAN ART IN \$5 MILLION MELBOURNE AUCTION

Fred Williams, Rupert Bunny, Tom Roberts, John Brack, Grace Cossington Smith, Emily Kngwarreye, Arthur Streeton, Arthur Boyd, Hans Heysen, & Norman Lindsay

Christie's Director and Head of Australian & International Paintings, Jon Dwyer says the company's April 10 & 11 auction catalogue showcases significant works by leading Australian artists across the spectrum of eras from the 19th to 21st Centuries. Many works, notably **Fred Williams'** 'Upwey Landscape' (estimate \$500,000-800,000) and **Rupert Bunny's** 'A Game Of Patience' (estimate \$250,000-350,000) have not been previously offered at auction in Australia. The Bunny has been repatriated from Uruguay, where it was last seen at a sale thirty years ago and the Williams derives from a significant corporate collection where it has been held since being acquired in 1966.

"A hallmark of this sale is the number of works Christie's have been able to secure for sale from international collectors of Australian art. We have consignments from clients in Europe, Asia, South America and the United States. In most cases they are paintings which have seldom been available to the market, in some instances it is the first time they have been offered at auction. Undoubted highlights are 'Upwey Landscape' and 'A Game of Patience' but many other works are equally notable. These include a marvelous Hans Heysen, 'In the Ranges' (estimate \$50,000-70,000) consigned by the Estate of H.R.H. The Prince Henry, Duke of Gloucester, KG, KT, KP; a superb Arthur Streeton 'Barnes Common, Surrey' (estimate \$120,000-180,000); John Brack's 'Halt' (estimate \$240,000-280,000) and a magnificent collection of seven important Tom Roberts' portraits (estimates from \$35,000 to \$100,000) said Jon Dwyer.
