The diversity of the collection which included ceramics, paintings, furniture and textiles attracted a wide audience of private collectors, institutions and trade. Many new bidders also entered the market, both from West and East, which supported prices for all the segments of the collection and created a lively and energetic ambiance. We were particularly pleased with the results obtained for the copper-red and blue-decorated porcelain bottle which fetched nearly \$300,000 and the eight-panel screen *Hunting scenes* which went for \$66,000. Another highlight of the sale was the 15th century white porcelain jar from the Choson period, which realized \$284,800."
