- Matt Dunning's No.17 spare gold and green short-sleeved Australia shirt from the 2003 Rugby World Cup Final, England v. Australia, played on 22 November 2003 in Sydney Leonard swapped his England spare with Dunning after the match
- Olivier Milloud's No.17 match-worn blue and white short-sleeved France shirt from the 2003 Rugby World Cup Semi-Final, England v. France, played on 16 November 2003 in Sydney this match marked Leonard's World Record 112th cap, making him the most capped player in Rugby Union history
- Adam Jones's No.3 match-worn red short-sleeved Wales shirt from the 2003 Rugby World Cup Quarter-Final, England v. Wales, played on 9 November 2003 in Brisbane
- Pablo Lemoine's No.3 match-worn blue short-sleeved Uruguay shirt from the 2003 Rugby World Cup Group C match, England v. Uruguay, played on 2 November 2003 in Brisbane
- Jeremy Tomuli's No.3 match-worn blue short-sleeved Samoa shirt from the 2003 Rugby Word Cup Group C match, England v. Samoa, played on 26 October 2003 in Melbourne
- Lawrence Sephaka's numberless (torn off during the game) match-worn green shortsleeved South Africa shirt from the 2003 Rugby World Cup Group C match, England v. South Africa, played on 18 October 2003 in Perth
- Sosso Nikolaneko's No.17 match-worn black and maroon short-sleeved Georgia shirt from the 2003 Rugby World Cup Group C match, England v. Georgia, played on 12 October 2003 in Perth
