"Tonight's auction was dominated by important historic jewels such as the diamond rivière formerly owned by Queen Olga of Greece, which realised over SFr.1 million and the 18th century diamond bracelet formerly part of the Russian Crown Jewels, that sold for \$260,000. Furthermore, period signed jewels by Boivin, Cartier, Schlumberger and Van Cleef & Arpels achieved strong prices throughout the sale. This brings the Spring season for jewellery in Switzerland to a total of \$36,790,000."
