This is well illustrated by the top lots of the sale including the Louis XV commode by Leleu, which sold for £590,400, the pair of carved marble figures of Venus and Mercury which sold for £310,400 and the Louis XV rhinoceros mantle clock which realised £232,000. An exceptional feature of the auction was the exquisite collection of mirrors which realised a total of £553,800."
