“We are particularly pleased by the high price achieved for two cases of 1982 Château Lafite-Rothschild which sold for £13,500 each. The market continues to rise for the most sought after vintages of top Bordeaux, with many lots in a selection of attractive consignments of 1995, 1996 and 1999 clarets selling well over the top end of the estimates.

Fine Burgundy also sold well with the extremely rare bottles of 19th century Romanée-Conti selling for £4,500 and £3,375 respectively while a single bottle of the 1990 vintage went for £4,725 and a rare case of 1990 Echézeaux from Georges and Henri Mayer sold for £10,687,” said **Harriet Joll, Senior Specialist in the Wine Department.**

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
