There is also a fabulous selection of long forgotten holiday destinations, favourite old-time cruiseships and many vintage advertising posters. Estimates range from £300 to £7,000 and with most lots under £1,000, this is the perfect way to add a touch of uniqueness to any room in the home.

Particular highlights of the sale include rare railway posters from *Terence Cuneo (1907-1996)* (estimates from £400); posters by *Edwin Septimus Scott (1879-1962)* featuring popular old-time UK holiday destinations (estimates from £800) and a selection of posters by *Frank Newbould (1887-1950)* featuring the East Coast as a holiday destination in the 1930s (estimates from £600).

For Londoners, a sizeable proportion of the sale features advertising posters for London's tramways, railways, Regents Park Zoo, and many of the popular London tourist attractions (estimates from £250). Moving onto a beverage theme, there is a selection of beautiful French posters by *Leonetto Capiello (1875 – 1942)* advertising a host of decadent beverages from 1920s (estimates from £600). Worldwide holiday destinations featured include St Moritz, Monte Carlo, Madagascar, Switzerland and South Africa.

Both the view and auction itself offer the perfect trip down memory lane, and with the public viewing starting at the weekend, there has never been a better excuse to start furnishing your home at Auction.
