Picasso's <i>Buste de Femme au Chapeau</i> set a new world record for a linocut by the artist, realising £334,100. The strength of demand for works by Henri de Toulouse-Lautrec, Pablo Picasso, and Henri Matisse from the Private American Collection demonstrates the continued appeal of prints by 20th century masters, whilst the sale ended with a flourish of high prices for Pop Art," said <b>Richard Lloyd, Head of Prints, Christie's London.</b></p>
