FIVE NEW ARTIST RECORDS FOR EMILIO SÁNCHEZ, ANTONIO CARO, CORNELIA VARGAS, ELIZABETH JOBIM, JORGE RODRÍGUEZ DIEZ

New York – Christie's online-only sale of <u>Latin American Art</u> totaled \$1,362,125, marking the highest ever sale total for an online sale of Latin American Art. The sale was sold 92% by lot and 116% hammer above low estimate. The sale was led by two works on paper by **Fernando Botero**, <u>Man with Horse</u>, which sold for \$93,750, and <u>Still life</u>, which achieved \$62,500.

The sale established six new records for the below artists:
