Comment: Laura Lindsay, Director and head of sale: "We are delighted to have achieved the highest ever total for an auction of Scottish art at Christie's. We sold an impressive selection of 18 Colourist works, the majority of which were fresh to the market, for a total of £1,932,650, the highest total for a group of colourists anywhere since Christie's auction dedicated to this group in 1989. Strong results were seen throughout today's sale, from William Aikman's (1682-1731) portrait of the 2nd Duke of Argyll which realised £55,200, to *Adam and Eve* by Sir Robin Philipson (1916-1992) which sold for £48,000, a new record price for the artist at auction. After a campaign which saw highlights exhibited in London, Paris and New York prior to the ever-popular pre-sale view in Edinburgh, we were particularly pleased to see 28% of lots from today's sale bought by overseas buyers and the majority of the sale bought by private clients. We now look forward to the first dedicated sale of Scottish Art to take place in London on 27 April 2007 which will offer a section devoted to contemporary Scottish art, and the annual Scottish Sale at the Assembly Rooms on 25 October 2007."
