Pavilion Online - Chinese Art Online Sale Continues Until 7 June

Hong Kong – This spring, Christie's Chinese Ceramics and Works of Art live auctions achieved a total of HK\$245,570,700/ US\$31,432,235, with 60% of lots sold above their pre-sale high estimates.



Top lot of the sales was **lot** 2863 – A MAGNIFICENT AND EXTREMELY RARE LARGE *DOUCAI* VASE, QIANLONG SIX-CHARACTER SEAL MARK IN UNDERGLAZE BLUE AND OF THE PERIOD (1736-1795) (shown above), from the Collection of The Munson-Williams-Proctor Arts Institute, which sold for **HK\$34,050,000/ US\$4,357,961**, with sale proceeds to benefit The Helen Munson Williams Acquisition Fund.

The live auction achieved HK\$83,163,000/ US\$10,646,145, led by lot 2725 - A VERY RARE AND FINELY CARVED CELADON-GLAZED 'DRAGON' BOTTLE VASE, QIANLONG INCISED SIX-CHARACTER SEAL MARK AND OF THE PERIOD (1736-1795), sold for HK\$17,250,000/ US\$2,208,266 (shown below).


