Los Angeles — Christie's online sale <u>Domaine de la Romanée-Conti</u>, <u>The Pride of Vosne-Romanée: An Exceptional Single Owner Collection</u> totaled \$1,626,750, with 100% of the lots sold, and 113% hammer above low estimate. The top lot of the sale was a group of three bottles of Domaine de la Romanée-Conti, Romanée-Conti 2002 in the original wooden case (lot 1), which sold for \$68,750. Other notable results included a 12-bottle group of Domaine de la Romanée-Conti, Assortment 1995 (lot 70), which brought \$60,000; another group of 12 bottles of Domaine de la Romanée-Conti, Assortment 1995 (lot 71), which also realized \$60,000; a sixbottle grouping of Domaine de la Romanée-Conti, La Tâche 2005 (lot 17) that fetched \$52,500; and a 12-bottle group of Domaine de la Romanée-Conti, Richebourg 2003 (lot 31), which achieved \$52,500. Christie's set two world records for highest price per bottle with this sale. A three-magnum group of Domaine de la Romanée-Conti, Richebourg 2009 (lot 40) brought \$35,000, and a two-bottle set of Domaine de la Romanée-Conti, Echézeaux 2008 (lot 66), realized \$6,875.
