In a select 784-lot sale, we saw exceptional results for a 30-case lot of Château Mouton-Rothschild 1986 that totaled \$288,000 and a new United States record price for a dozen bottles of the legendary Hermitage, La Chapelle 1961 which sold for \$252,000. Together with our other recent wine sales in Los Angeles and New York, which included the 100% sold *Quintessential Modern Cellar* and the *Rarities from the Cellars of Mähler-Besse*, the sale total for our intense 10-day period of wine sales at Christie's in the Americas totaled \$13,977,000."
