This November, as part of the Popular Culture Film Sale, the movies are coming to Christie's South Kensington as a distinctive selection of Vintage Film Posters pay tribute to all genres of cinema history, from cult horror and sci-fi films to the icons of the silver screen. With James Bond, Clint Eastwood, James Cagney, Paul Newman and Steve McQueen to name a few, all the boys' favourites feature and with estimates starting at just £300 this sale provides an ideal chance to take a trip down memory lane.

For science fiction fans there is a choice of eye-catching 1950s feature film posters, such as the artwork for the 1957 comedy *Invasion of the Saucer Men* (estimated at £1,500-2,000), the film that saw 'teenagers vs. saucer men'! Alternatively, there is Reynold Brown's striking artwork depicting the wealthy heiress Nancy Archer (Allison Hayes) who grew to the size of a giantess after an encounter with an enormous extra-terrestrial from the '50s low budget yet classic, *Attack of the Fifty Foot Woman* (estimated at £2,500-3,500).

Meanwhile for those who prefer their sirens smouldering and their heroes racing Brigitte Bardot and Steve McQueen are happy to oblige. Et Dieu...Crea La Femme (estimated at £300-500) is widely recognized as the film which launched Bardot into the public spotlight, generating her sex kitten status and inciting world-wide fame for her lead role in this controversial, sultry drama depicting a feverish trail of lust and love between Bardot's character and two brothers. Whilst Steve McQueen sets pulses pounding as classic Porsche 917s and Ferrari 512s career around Le Mans (estimated at £300-500); a subject matter close to McQueen's heart, the film generated a cult following for the iconic 'King of Cool's accurate portrayal of race track drama.
