The sale offered an impressive selection of works from ancient Greek, Roman, Byzantine, Egyptian and the Near Eastern cultures, ranging in date from the 3rd millennium B.C. to the 7th century A.D. In total, Antiquities made \$5,464,494, selling 91% by lot and 111% hammer of its low estimate.

The top lot of the sale was a Roman marble portrait head of the Empress Faustina Minor, which realized \$756,000, an impressive 189% above its low estimate. Additional sale top lots include an over-lifesized Roman marble torso of Mercury, which realized \$428,400, Roman marble Asclepius, which realized \$390,600, and a Cycladic marble female figure, which realized \$352,800.
