

SELECTIONS FROM THE GEDDY LEE COLLECTION AND IMPORTANT BASEBALL MEMORABILIA LIVE AND ONLINE SALE TOTALS NEARLY \$7 MILLION

NEW YORK – Christie's and [Hunt Auctions](#) are proud to announce results for Selections from the Geddy Lee Collection and Important Baseball Memorabilia [live](#) and [online](#). In total, the two sales achieved \$6,863,976, with the live sale totaling \$6,543,684 and the online sale totaling \$320,292.

The top lot of the live sale was a rare **1938 Babe Ruth Brooklyn Dodgers** professional model road uniform, which realized \$882,000. Additional top lots include a **Historically Significant 1968 Hank Aaron Atlanta Braves Professional Model Home Jersey Worn to Hit His 500th Career Home Run** which realized \$567,000.

Exceptional results were achieved from the Selections from the Geddy Lee Collection a **Single Signed Baseball by Scarce President Herbert Hoover** which sold for \$214,200 eight times over its low estimate of \$25,000. Additionally, an **Important Civil War soldiers with baseball equipment photograph** from the Gladstone Collection sold for \$113,400, eleven times its low estimate of \$10,000.

The top lot of the online portion of the auction was a **Mickey Mantle single signed and inscribed baseball: Brooks Robinson play at third base** from the Selections from the Geddy Lee Collection, which realized \$30,240. Another top lot

was a **Baseball 'Ladies' Day' trade sign** from the Gladstone Collection of Baseball Art, which sold for \$9,450, an impressive thirty-seven times its low estimate of \$250.

Iconic collections of this rarity and import are well documented to raise standards for their related mediums. 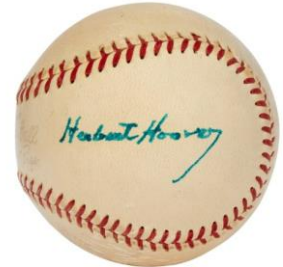

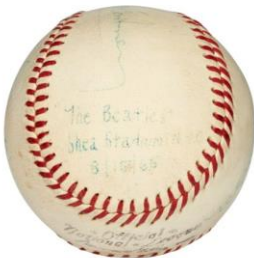

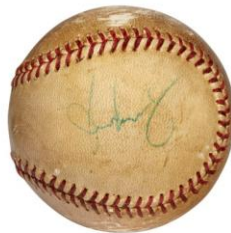

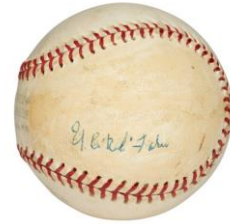
