"Christie's achieved a very healthy result for its Geneva Autumn watch sale, which totalled SFr.17,881,000, exceeding the low pre-sale estimate and selling 88% in value and 82% by lot. The auction attracted an international audience composed mainly of private collectors and museum curators who reacted well to a quality sale. Over 125 bidders from Asia, US, Europe and Canada chose Christie's LIVE to participate in the auction.

The Watch Department reconfirmed its leadership position by realising strong prices in all value categories for the rarest pieces by makers such as Patek Philippe, Rolex (lot 80, doubling its low estimate); Audemars Piguet (lot 69, quadrupling its low estimate); Piaget (lots 235,236, tripling their low estimate) and Cartier (lot 206, tripling its low estimate). Christie's continues to be the leading marketplace for the sale and purchase of fine and rare watches that are both fresh to the market and realistically estimated."
