COMMENT: "Today's was the most successful afternoon session of Post-War & Contemporary art ever held at Christie's," said Andrew Massad, Vice President and Specialist for the Post-War and Contemporary Art department. "Bidding was vigorous and highly competitive both in the packed saleroom and on the telephones for works by young artists fresh to the market as well as for those by classic Contemporary artists of the 1960s through the '80s. New world auction records were set for six artists this afternoon."

Christie's fall 2003 sales of Post-War and Contemporary Art realized a total of \$85,094,174. Overall, Christie's fall 2003 sales of Impressionist & Modern Art, Post-War & Contemporary Art totaled \$223,499,034.
