COMMENT: **Pola Antebi**, Senior Vice President, Specialist Head of the Chinese Ceramics & Works of Art Department said: "We are thrilled with today's results. The Robert Chang collection broke many records, including the highest price for a work of art at auction in Asia and the worldwide auction record for a piece of Qing porcelain. Fierce bidding from international collectors and dealers resulted in another record for a very rare blue and white dragon vase which now holds the world record price for a piece of Kangxi porcelain. The sale was Robert Chang's third auction of Imperial ceramics at Christie's and was characterized by pieces of remarkable rarity and quality features which are particularly appreciated in today's market.

Pieces from the collection of Alan and Simone Hartman were enthusiastically contested both on the telephone and in a packed saleroom, with a significant number of pieces selling for multiples of their original estimates. The extremely rare white jade libation cup and an exquisite vase and cover were among the most coveted items each reaching a record price in their own categories.

The afternoon session began with an especially good group of 14th and 15th century porcelain drew a great deal of attention, as did the *famille rose* porcelains. Excellent results were also achieved in other areas such as, scholars objects, Buddhist art and lacquer.

Today's sale total of HK\$540,753,199 marks the highest total ever achieved at Christie's worldwide in this sale category. The Chinese works of art total for 2006 is HK\$872,165,000, nearly twice that of 2004 or 2005 - a fitting celebration of our 20th anniversary year of Christie's Hong Kong."
