COMMENT: **Pola Antebi**, Senior Vice President, Specialist Head of the Chinese Ceramics & Works of Art Department, said: "We are extremely pleased with the excellent results of both ceramics and works of art sales. Many items on offer fetched multiples of their pre-sale estimates, most notably lot 1313, which at HK\$19,160,000, sold for nearly five times the low estimate. The Yuan *Jinxiang Ting* jar, lot 1403, established the second highest price for a Yuan vessel, and has been surpassed only by a similar example sold at Christie's London in July for £15,688,000. There was in addition exceptionally strong interest in Chinese lacquers and Imperial decorative objects."
