"Diamonds brought exceptional prices at the Hong Kong auction of December 2nd despite the ever-challenging financial environment. A round diamond of 10.98cts and a pair of round diamonds of 16.11 and 16.08cts brought in excess of \$170,000/ct, a price very much in line with the top of the market of a few months ago. Kashmir sapphires and Burma rubies also achieved very strong prices with two lots selling for over US\$1.2m each. The Asian market showed its resilience and appetite for jadeite, fine diamonds and jewels. This auction demonstrates that when the right selection is offered for sale at the correct price buyers are still very active," said Vickie Sek, Director of the Jewellery and Jadeite Department, Christie's Asia.
