"Christie's auction of Old Master Paintings in Milan was undoubtedly a sale of European appeal. Mainly private clients purchased works of excellent and private provenance, and key to the success of the sale was the presence of rare masterworks of the Italian Baroque, such as Guercino's *Diana* and an exquisite picture by Franceschini. Additionally several decorative paintings, such as the Venetian landscape by Bossoli and the impressive French view of a castle in a park, achieved high prices with the latter selling for more than four times its low estimate. The total result, almost double that of our last May sale, illustrated collectors' enduring interest of old masters paintings and their appreciation of great quality."
