The 53.71ct D flawless diamond was immediately named *Dubai Magnificence* by its new owner, Amer Radwan of Radwan Diamond Corporation in Dubai, who commented, "In a market as competitive as it is, I am thrilled to have been able to acquire such a perfect diamond."
