As we can see from the intense competition that resulted in top prices for works by blue-chip artists such as Wu Guangzhong and Zeng Fanzhi, the market for Chinese 20th Century and Contemporary art continues to be steady and healthy. Asian buying remains strong, making the winning bids for nine out of our top ten works, among a global buying base. We look forward to continuing the momentum at our Day Sales on November 28th, 2010." said **Eric Chang, International Director of Asian Contemporary Art and Chinese 20th Century Art.**
