Rare and mature wines performed very well, such as the imperial of Robert Mondavi Cabernet Reserve 1974 which sold for \$1,573 against a pre-sale low estimate of \$700 and the super rare 5 bottle-lot of Quintarelli Amabile del Cere - Passito Bia 1990 which sold for \$1,815 against a low estimate of \$200.
