The Marc and Victoria Sursock collection of Orientalist paintings and drawings performed very well with the works by Edwin Lord Weeks of India achieving strong results. Eugene Delacroix's study for his *Apollo ceiling* in the Louvre-Paris fetched a world record price for an oil sketch by the artist. We are also delighted that the *View of Cleves* by B. C. Koekkoek was purchased by the Museum Haus Koekkoek and will be the main attraction in their upcoming exhibition commemorating the 150 year anniversary of his death.
