Hong Kong – The autumn season's three sales of Chinese Ceramics and Works of Art on Wednesday, November 28 achieved HK\$523,562,875 (US\$67,906,105), and sold in excess of 73% by lot and 82% by value.

The sale of **Fine Chinese Furniture from Private American Collections** realised HK\$104,002,250 (US\$13,489,092) with an overall sold rate of 87% by lot and 95% by value. “With this sale from private American collections, Christie's delivered a well selected range of Chinese furniture, which met the growing demand for the category in Asia. Traditionally collected by Americans and in the West, the strong result of the sale confirmed Christie's strategic decision to present this collection in Hong Kong,” said **Christopher Engle, Senior Specialist, Chinese Ceramics & Works of Art**.

The sale of **Important Chinese Lacquer from the Lee Family Collection, Part III** realised HK\$34,928,500 (US\$4,530,226) with an overall sold rate of 72% by lot and 77% by value. **Pola Antebi, International Director of the Chinese Ceramics & Works of Art Department**, said, “The sale offered the third and final part of Chinese lacquer from the Lee Family Collection, regarded as the most researched and exhibited single-owner lacquer collection. This was the first time a series of sales has been dedicated to a single-owner collection of lacquer. Strong Asian interest, supported by international participation, underlined the sale, indicative of the strength of this collecting category in the region.”

The sale of **Important Chinese Ceramics & Works of Art** realised HK\$384,632,125 (US\$49,886,787) with an overall sold rate of 70% by lot and 79% by value. **Chi Fan Tsang, Specialist Head of Chinese Ceramics & Works of Art**, said, “Anticipation and energy filled the salesroom as buyers participated in fast-paced and competitive bidding. The strong performance of the John Insley Blair collection demonstrated the strength of the market for works of quality and rarity from important private collections. Strategic sourcing, depth in the market and a well curated sale produced a strong result, signifying the undiminished international demand for great works of art.”
