There was fierce bidding for several works highlighted by a world record for a work on paper by Orientalist Marius Bauer realizing €61,500. Leading the sale was Old Master Jan van Dalen I, which fetched a world auction record for the artist realizing €253,500/\$342,276/£212,687, far exceeding its pre-sale estimate of €100,000-150,000. A further world record achieved was Romantic artist Coen Greive. Bidders from 21 countries and multiple museums participated in this week's sale. We now look forward to our next sale of Old Masters & 19th century Art on 13 May 2014."
