## Alexander Montague-Sparey, Director, Head of Department - Photographs, London

The sale of Photographs was led by stellar results for the work of contemporary masters and the private collection of works by Peter Beard from the Hotel Nord Pinus, which achieved a total of £,551,525, against an estimate of £,335,000-£,490,000. Four world auction records were achieved for fashion photographers Louise Dahl-Wolf and Javier Vallhonrat, as well as contemporary British artists Marcus Lyon and Tim Flach. We saw consistently strong demand for the work of Helmut Newton, including a preparatory polaroid, Big Nude III, which sold for £,22,500, against an estimate of £,6,000-8,000.
