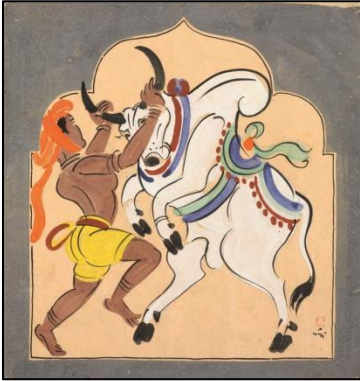

## CHRISTIE'S NEW YORK ANNOUNCES ASIAN ART WEEK OF FALL 2013



**New York** – Christie's September 2013 Asian Art Week will be comprised of eight impressive sales that will take place over the course of four days, from September 17-20. The week will feature property from several renowned private collections of contemporary Indian works, jade carvings, archaic bronzes, and more. In conjunction with Asian Art Week, *Super/Natural Contemporary Korean Art*, Christie's first private selling exhibition of the genre, will be held in the 20<sup>th</sup> floor galleries from September 12-27. The exhibition will focus on four artists' interest in nature and the hyperreal. Further details of Asian Art Week will be announced in the coming weeks.
