Imperial Russian orders continued to perform well, with a Collar Of The Order Of St. Andrew The First-Called realizing \$315,750 (estimate: \$150,000-250,000) and a Gold and Enamel Badge of the Order Of St. Andrew The First-Called realizing \$291,750 (estimate: \$80,000-120,000). We look forward to our next sale of Russian Art in London on June 3."
