Christie's is offering some of the finest examples of the 35cm Birkin handbags by Hermès.



An exotic Birkin, like the Graphite Niloticus Crocodile, offers a color that is rarely seen in Crocodile. Even more rarely seen in Crocodile, is a matte finish. The combination of Graphite Crocodile with Gold Hardware is also unique as this color is more often combined with Palladium Hardware. Our other highlight is a Birkin done in the finest skin that Hermès makes - Porosus Crocodile. This bag features small scales that are nearly perfectly symmetrical across the bag. The dye process for Hermès to create lighter colors is extremely difficult. Shades that are as light as Poussiere are very rare which makes this bag one of the finest examples of a Porosus Crocodile Birkin.
