Philippe Garner, Deputy Chairman and the sale's auctioneer, remarked: "The 20/21 Design auction demonstrated the great strength of the market for Art Deco, as proven by the excellent results achieved by the Marsha Miro Collection, which realized a total of \$2,415,875. The exceptional pieces that Mrs. Miro acquired around 30 years ago attracted a wide international audience, led by a unique commission dining room by Eugène Printz comprising a sideboard, dining room table, and dining chairs, which sold for a combined total of \$1,194,250. Also among the highlights was the carpet commissioned by the Maharaja of Indore for his legendary Modernist palace, which set a world auction record for the artist when it realized \$437,000. Choice works by Jean Dunand commanded solid prices, notably, a small box and cover formerly in the collection of Andy Warhol, which greatly exceeded its estimate of \$8,000-12,000 when it sold for \$52,500."
