Virgilio Garza, Head of Latin American Art, commented: "From influential artists such as Joaquín Torres-García, Rufino Tamayo, and Fernando Botero, to some of Brazil's most influential figures of the 20th and 21st centuries, the auction reflected the strength of the current market for Latin American art. The demand for works of all mediums by Botero, continued to reach new heights at Christie's, with 16 out of 19 works by the artist selling to achieve a combined total of \$3.4 million. A record price was set for a work on paper by Rufino Tamayo, with Mujer con sandía realizing \$473,000; the work had never been on the public market before, undoubtedly contributing to its appeal to collectors. New world auction records were also set for Ernesto Icaza, Alicia Penalba, Tunga, Oswaldo Vigas, Pedro Ruiz, Alexander Apóstol, and Alfredo Zalce."
