Marie-Laurence Tixier, Head of the Department : "We are delighted with the strong result of today's Jewellery sale in Paris, totaling €5,768,850. International Jewellery collectors from all continents bid enthusiastically in the room, over multiple phone lines and via Christie's LIVE resulting in 95% of the 164 jewels finding a new owner.

The sale has set a new record for Christie's France by selling the most expensive jewel ever, a 19th century natural pearl and diamond brooch realised €1,021,500.

The highlight of the finely curated selection of Avant-Garde jewels was an Art Deco necklace by Gérard Sandoz selling for €115,500 and therefore more than tripling its pre-sale estimate. An Art Deco emerald, diamond and platinum brooch by Van Cleef & Arpels sold for €391,500 against the pre-sale estimate of €70,000-100,000 expressing the continued demand for quality jewels, diamonds and coloured stones that was seen throughout the sale".
