CHRISTIE'S WINE ONLINE/NYC: ALL-AMERICAN SALE ONLINE AUCTION: JUNE 28 - JULY 12, 2016



New York – Christie's Wine is proud to round out its spring auction roster with the fourth annual **Christie's Wine Online/NYC: All-American Sale**, kicking off on Tuesday, June 28.

Rare American Wines, and, for the first time, Whiskies lead the selection with cult classics including **Pappy Van Winkle**, **Sine Qua Non** and **Screaming Eagle**. The span of American vintages in this sale evoke a historically relevant time and place for the wines and spirits on offer and are true venerable pieces of American liquor history.

The innovation and uniquely free winemaking methods of Sine Qua Non, the history of Chateau Montelena, and the distinct American expression of Cabernet Sauvignon from Screaming Eagle are all evoked through the diverse and decidedly unique sale. Whiskey highlights include a **very rare and unique carboy of Pre-Prohibition bourbon** from the now defunct Cedar Brook Distillery and a rare lot of **A**. H. Hirsch 16 Year Old, distilled in 1974.

More than 170 lots comprise the sale with rare bottlings from Sine Qua Non start from \$300 and full case quantities of **Chateau Montelena** from the 1980s and 1990s from under \$1,000. The entirety of the sale is now live and available for browsing here:
