On 26 and 27 November 2016, Christie's Hong Kong held three auctions for Asian 20th Century & Contemporary Art and the special themed **The Pioneers** evening sale which together realised a total of **HK\$677,668,750/US\$87,753,125**.

**Over 30% of lots sold in the two Day Sales exceeded high estimates**
