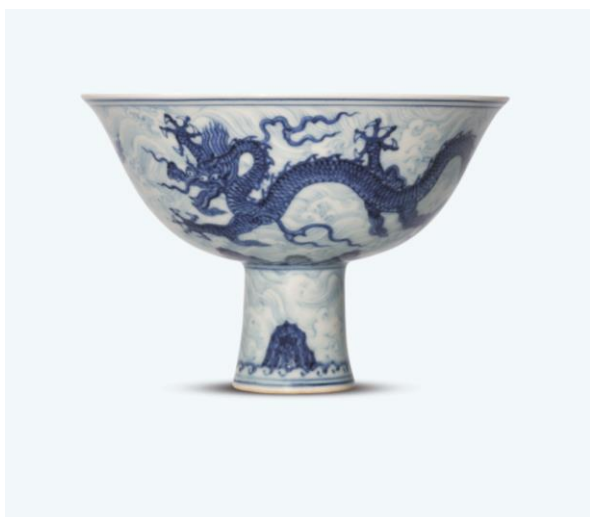
34% of Lots Exceeded High Estimate
