On 27 and 28 May 2017, Christie's Hong Kong held three auctions for Asian 20<sup>th</sup> Century & Contemporary Art - Contemporaries: Voices from East and West, Asian Contemporary Art Day Sale and Asian 20th Century Art Day Sale which together realised a total of HK\$731,728,750/ US\$94,359,895.

Eric Chang, Deputy Chairman, International Director of Asian 20<sup>th</sup> Century and Contemporary Art, commented: "This season marked the debut of a truly global evening sale uniting the very best of Western and Asian art. Bidding was particularly strong for The Contemporaries Evening Sale which achieved 92% sold by lot and establishing three auction world records. The success of this inaugural evening sale, built around a global theme, breaking all geographical and cultural boundaries, epitomises the growing trend of Asian buyers gravitating towards Western art and vice-versa.

It was particularly encouraging to see a truly international mix of buyers in this sale with over 20% of lots bought by clients from outside Asia. The three sales together achieved 29 records for emerging and established artists demonstrating strong support for a broad spectrum of works and price points".
