This autumn, Christie's Hong Kong will host its second season of sales from 24-29 November, accompanied by a series of lectures, previews and art forums. Works on offer include an exciting mix of Western and Asian works, encompassing the key categories of: **Asian 20th Century and Contemporary Art, Chinese Classical and Modern Paintings, Chinese Ceramics and Works of Arts**, as well as a full array of luxury items spanning- **Magnificent Jewels, Important Watches, Fine and Rare Wine and Handbags and Accessories**.

Among the many highlights this season, Christie's will present for the first time in Asia an evening sale collaboration between the Chinese Paintings and Chinese Works of Art departments to take place on 27 November, titled "**Court, Studio, Atelier – An Evening Sale of Chinese Works of Art and Paintings from the Ming Dynasty**".

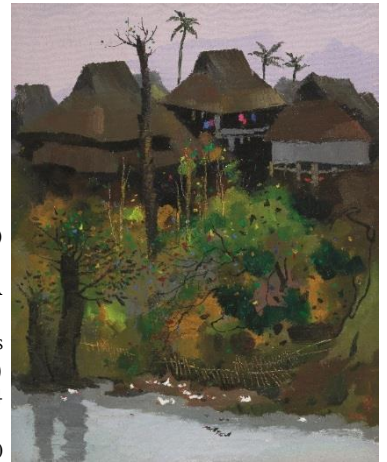

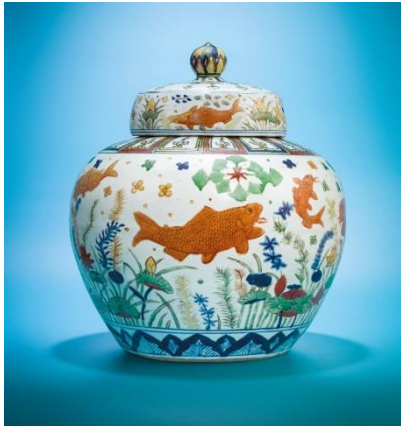

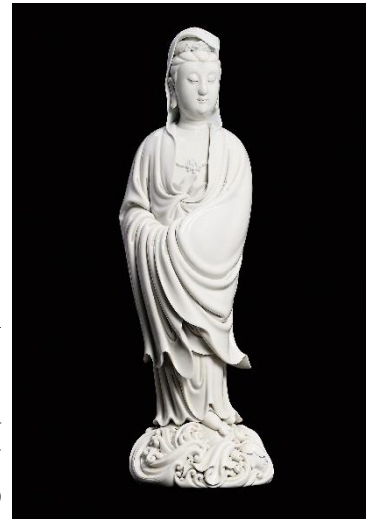

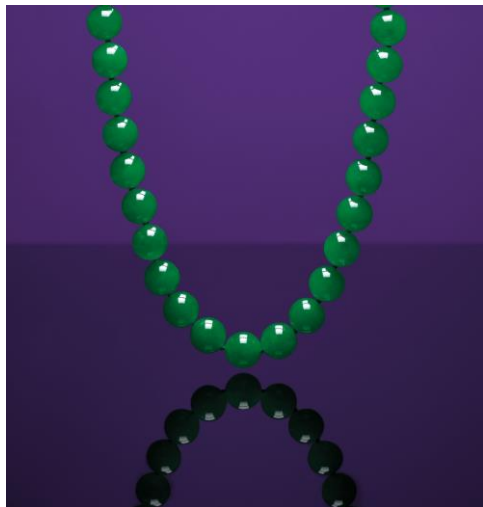

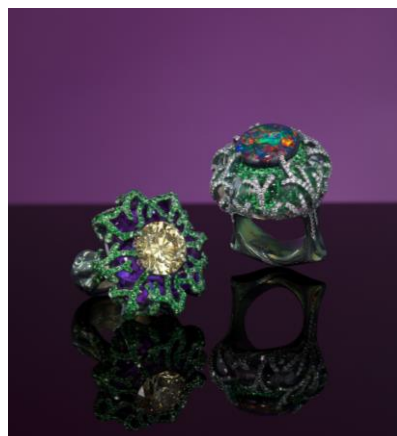

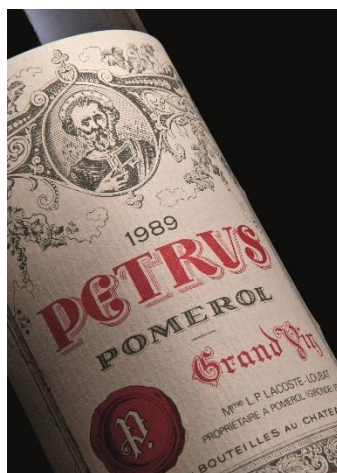
