AN INAUGURAL AUCTION OF MASTERPIECES FROM THE MEIJI ERA

Hong Kong – Marking the 150th anniversary of the Meiji Restoration, Christie's is honoured to present an inaugural sale of 41 exquisite works of art from the Meiji era entitled "The Meiji Aesthetics: Selected Masterpieces from a Private Asian Collection", to take place on 27 November.

This remarkable collection comprises of almost 30 extremely rare *Jizai* sculptures and a dozen important fine metal artworks. Offering collectors a glimpse into the unique and timeless beauty of the Meiji era are the highlights - An Important Iron Articulated Sculpture of a Dragon by Tanaka Tadayoshi (Estimate: HKD 6,500,000-9,500,000) which is believed to be the largest articulated dragon in the world, and an Iron Articulated Sculpture of an Eagle by Itao Shinjiro (Estimate: HKD5,500,000-7,000,000).

Takaaki Murakami, Head of Sale, commented, "We are thrilled to present the first ever dedicated sale of Meiji works of art in Asia, with 41 superbly crafted artworks selected for our global collectors. Complimenting the array of Chinese Works of Arts this season, these aesthetically intriguing and technically groundbreaking works represent one of the first areas of Asian art that was understood by the Western world and reveal the relevance across Asia of this art form".

As a highly specialized art form in Japan, 'Jizai' is defined as articulated and movable three-dimensional works in animal forms made of finely hammered metal. Invented by the armorers turned sculptors and metalsmiths in the late 19th century, Jizai transformed hundreds of years of craftsmanship in arms and armor making to a new discipline that has fascinated local and international collectors for more than a century.

Today, such works are housed in the collections of the world's most prominent museums such as the British Museum and the Boston Museum of Fine Arts.

The twelve fine metal wares on offer are equally significant, with the artists responsible for their creation such as Yamada Sobi (1871-1916), Unno Minjo (1873-1910), Yotsuya Masami (1876-1941) and Oshima John (1858-1940) achieving international recognition in numerous World Expositions, helping to spark the early fascination of Asian art forms in the West.
